

## **\*\*Five-Day Bible Reading Plan and Devotional: Walking with Nehemiah\*\***

### **\*\*Day 1: Answering the Call to Build\*\***

- \*Reading: Nehemiah 1:1-4\*
- \*Devotion\*: Today, we begin our journey with Nehemiah as he learns about the destruction of Jerusalem's walls. His immediate response is one of deep mourning, showing us that acknowledging our pain is the first step towards healing and action. As you read these verses, reflect on what in your life or community causes your heart to break. How might God be calling you to respond?
- \*Reflection Question\*: What are the "walls" in your life or community that God might be calling you to help rebuild?

### **\*\*Day 2: Seeking Guidance Through Prayer\*\***

- \*Reading: Nehemiah 1:5-11\*
- \*Devotion\*: On this day, we witness Nehemiah's heartfelt prayer. He doesn't rush into action but instead seeks divine direction and favor. Consider the ways in which you approach significant decisions in your life. Do you turn to prayer and seek God's guidance before acting?
- \*Reflection Question\*: When faced with a challenge, how can you incorporate prayer to seek God's wisdom and favor?

### **\*\*Day 3: The Courage to Show Vulnerability\*\***

- \*Reading: Nehemiah 2:1-5\*
- \*Devotion\*: Nehemiah's sadness in the presence of the king is a profound moment of vulnerability. He risks his position to advocate for his cause. Today, ponder the moments when God calls you to be courageous and honest about your emotions, even when it's risky. How can showing your true feelings be an opportunity for God to work through you?
- \*Reflection Question\*: Can you recall a time when being vulnerable led to a positive outcome in your life or someone else's?

### **\*\*Day 4: Favor and Provision from the King\*\***

- \*Reading: Nehemiah 2:6-9\*
- \*Devotion\*: As Nehemiah receives the king's support, we're reminded of God's provision in our own lives. He prepares the way for us, even when we don't see it. Today, reflect on the times when you have experienced God's provision. How did it come in forms you didn't expect?
- \*Reflection Question\*: How can you be a vessel for God's provision in someone else's life?

### **\*\*Day 5: Protected by Divine Authority\*\***

- \*Reading: Nehemiah 2:10-11, Psalm 23\*
- \*Devotion\*: With the king's letter and escort, Nehemiah is protected on his journey. Like Nehemiah, we can trust in God's protection over our lives. Today, meditate on Psalm 23 and the ways God shepherds you through life's valleys. Remember that even when opposition arises, you are under the watchful eye of the Good Shepherd.
- \*Reflection Question\*: How can the knowledge of God's protection give you peace in your current circumstances?

**\*\*Closing Thoughts\*\***: As we conclude our five-day devotional, consider how Nehemiah's story has spoken to you about faith, risk-taking, vulnerability, and God's faithful provision and protection. Carry these lessons with you as you face your own journey of rebuilding and renewal. Trust in the Lord's guidance and be open to the ways He is working through you for His purpose.
